

# Delaware Solar Timeline

01



**Research**

Begin by researching solar to decide whether it is the right choice for you and your energy needs.

02



**Availability**

Contact your utility to confirm the interconnection of solar is available in your area.

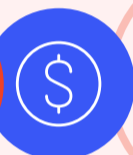
03



**Decision**

Schedule a home energy audit to make sure your home is energy-efficient so you don't over buy. Then, make the decision to go solar.

04



**Get Quotes**

Installing solar panels is a major financial commitment, so we recommend getting quotes from three or more installers.

05



**Selection**

Choose an installer and finalize your solar installation plan.

06



**Interconnection**

You or your installer should apply for interconnection with your utility prior to install.

07



**Incentives**

Research state and utility incentive programs you may be eligible for and note when applications are due for each.

08



**Installation**

Install the solar system.

09



**Approval**

Obtain the final approval to operate your solar system from your utility.

10



**Certification**

Apply for Delaware State Certification of your solar system with the Delaware Public Service Commission.

11



**Application**

Complete and submit all solar incentive applications you qualify for.

12



**SRECs**

Research SREC programs and apply to sell your SRECs if you have not already sold them through an incentive program.
